## AN INTRODUCTORY COURSE IN COGNITIVE BEHAVIORAL THERAPY AND INTERPERSONAL THERAPY \*\*

(Limited Seating)

Wednesday 6 June - All day

The course is intended for any member of the CF multidisciplinary team who wants to be introduced to, or updated about, Cognitive Behavioral Therapy (CBT) and Interpersonal Therapy (IPT) with the aim of improving mental health care for patients with Cystic Fibrosis and their families. This one-day course consists of a basic introduction in CBT and IPT. The course will highlight the principles of assessment and a variety of intervention techniques. CBT and IPT have been applied in medical settings for decades and the course will include examples of CBT and IPT approaches in CF.

## PHYSIOTHERAPY SHORT COURSE \*\* AIRWAY CLEARANCE TECHNIQUES: BASIC APPROACH

## NUTRITION MASTERCLASS - PRACTICAL MANAGEMENT OF NUTRITION ISSUES IN CF\*\*

(Limited Seating)

Tuesday 5 June - Half Day

This nutrition masterclass focuses on the practical aspects of assessing, monitoring and optimizing the nutritional status of Cystic fibrosis (CF) patients specific to the low- and middle-income economies healthcare setting. It is designed for all healthcare providers who have interests in the nutritional aspects of CF or who are new to CF. The aim will be to share effective nutritional management strategies where time, health care infrastructure and finance may be limited to optimize CF outcomes.

Topics will include: nutritional assessment (anthropometrics and dietary history), optimizing enzyme therapy, increasing calories/supplemental nutritional therapy, managing difficult feeding behaviours and effective treatment of early poor growth.

The course will be supported by experienced CF nutrition experts from across Europe and at the end of the course attendees will receive a certificate of attendance.

## PLENARY

## SYMPOSIA

The sessions, lasting 90 minutes, comprise 3 to 4 lectures by experts in the field covered by the symposium and specifically in the topic presented. Each presentation is followed by discussion time when all attendees are invited to ask questions about/discuss the presentation.

## WORKSHOPS

The sessions, lasting 90 minutes, comprise oral presentations of scientific work as outlined in the abstracts. The moderators of the workshop, experts in the field covered by the workshop, will introduce the different presentations and facilitate the discussion time when all attendees are invited to ask questions about/discuss the presentation.

## CASE PRESENTATIONS

Informative cases related to diagnosis or management of Cystic Fibrosis will be presented and discussed. A panel of experts in the field facilitates the discussion and foster exchange of information or discuss treatment possibilities based on their expertise and knowledge of the latest scientific publications.

## INTERACTIVE CASE STUDIES

The Interactive Case Studies session is an educational session using a voting module integrated in the ECFS Conference App.

This feature will allow the audience to answer questions asked by the presenter during the talk. Each interactive case presents an evolving patient history and a series of questions designed to test the diagnostic and/or therapeutic skills of the audience. The presenters will receive immediate feedback on their questions and the audience's treatment choices. The audience will also have the ability to compare their final scores with those of their peers. The interactive case study submission is open only to fellows who are under the age of 40 on 19 January 2018.
